

Terms and conditions

1. The participant must be at least 18 years old.
2. The participant must be physically and mentally healthy.
3. INSPIREnepal foundation has the right to refuse a placement or offer another placement in agreement with the participant. The confirmation of registration will be sent only if the participant and INSPIREnepal foundation have an agreement.
- 4.1 The participant is responsible for accuracy, completeness and reliability of the data and information provided to INSPIREnepal foundation by him. INSPIREnepal foundation will only get started if all the data provided by the participant.
- 4.2 If before or during the stay of the participant in Nepal shows that the information provided by the participant INSPIREnepal foundation incorrect, incomplete or unreliable, INSPIREnepal foundation is entitled to terminate the participation of the participant. In that case, the participant is not entitled to compensation or reimbursement of costs incurred and paid.
- 5.1 The participant must be in possession of a valid passport.
- 5.2 INSPIREnepal foundation can assist in applying for a visa. Application and obtaining any necessary visas remain the responsibility of the participant.
- 5.3 If the issuance of a visa is denied or if the visa is not or is not requested in time, the participant is not entitled to a refund of the program fee.
- 6.1 After confirmation of registration, the participant must pay a deposit for participation as stated in the confirmation within 14 days.
- 6.2 The remaining balance of the payment must be paid 30 days before the departure date.
- 6.3 Cancellation of the program, the participant will get back a portion of the down payment if the participant passes the cancellation on time, at least 31 days before departure date.
- 6.4 30 days before the departure date, the participant has no right to a refund if canceled since INSPIREnepal foundation has started working to arrange job and a place to stay and we want to maintain a good relationship with the host families.
- 7.1 INSPIREnepal foundation informs the participant about the rules, standards and guidelines that apply to participate in the program. If the participant fails to comply with these rules, standards and / or guidelines, INSPIREnepal foundation is entitled to terminate the participation of the participant. In that case, the participant is not entitled to reimbursement of costs incurred and paid.
- 7.2 The rules, standards and guidelines referred to in 7.1 may be given in writing or verbally.
- 7.3 The participant must take into account that the local customs and circumstances may differ from what he is used heavily. Under local customs and conditions, but also does not mean only the use, (eating) habits and rules of the family and the volunteers place. If it cannot on arrival in Nepal shows that the participant cope with the local customs and / or conditions and the participant program terminates prematurely, the participant is not entitled to a refund of the amount.
- 7.4 It may happen that the stay after all the preparations still disappointing, for example because it does not click in the host family or volunteer work is still not satisfactory. When the operator by that situation will change plans, there will be no refund. Well INSPIREnepal foundation will make every effort yet to find another host family or other volunteer work.

7.5 INSPIREnepal foundation will conduct its advice and / or guidance of the participant to the best of its ability and with due professional care. However INSPIREnepal foundation cannot guarantee the achievement of any intended results.

8.1 INSPIREnepal foundation cannot be held liable in case of illness, theft or other cases. The participant must have their own travel - cancellation - health insurance and take responsibility.

8.2 In case of damage incurred by the participant, the participant must pay the damages. This applies to damage to the host family, the volunteers place or the office of INSPIREnepal foundation.

9.1 If INSPIREnepal foundation force majeure, is prevented from fulfilling the agreement, INSPIREnepal foundation is entitled to implement the agreement to suspend. The participant in that case have no right to compensation for damages, costs or interest.

9.2 If a force majeure will include: war, threat of war, natural disasters, strikes, fire, accident or illness of personnel, operational failure, interfering statutory provisions and any other circumstance not only the will of Foundation Inspire Nepal depends.
